

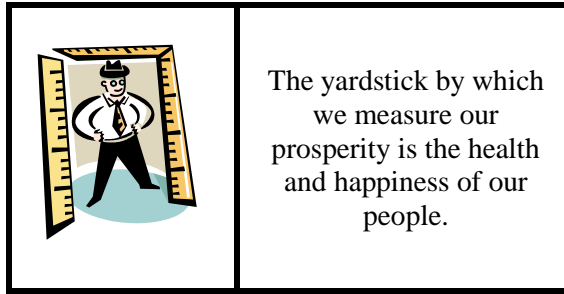
## Who needs shots?

Immunizations are available at no cost for children from birth to 18 years.

Children ages 4-5 need immunizations for entry into kindergarten:

- DTAP #5
- Polio #4
- MMR #2
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) #2

**Adults need immunizations too!**

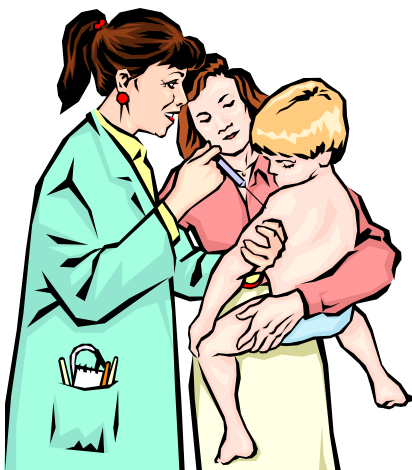
TDap is required for 11-18 year olds


Meningococcal (meningitis) vaccine is required for 11-18 year olds

Hepatitis A – Two doses are recommended for 11-18 year olds

Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine is available for males and females ages 11-18. Call for details.

\* Anyone receiving Varicella vaccine needs two doses



	
<b>Birth</b>	Hepatitis B #1 (HBV)
<b>2 months</b>	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, HBV #2, Rotavirus
<b>4 months</b>	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, Rotavirus
<b>6 months</b>	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, HBV #3, Rotavirus
<b>12 months</b>	MMR #1, Varicella #1, Hepatitis A #1
<b>15-18 months</b>	DTaP, Hib, PCV
<b>18 months</b>	Hepatitis A #2
<b>4-6 years</b>	DTaP, IPV, MMR #2, Varicella #2
<b>11-18 years</b>	Tdap, Menactra, HPV, Varicella #2*, Hepatitis A
<b>Every 7 years</b>	Tetanus booster

The health department can be a great resource. There is a nurse available Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM until 4:30 PM.
